

The Montessori Approach to the 6-12 year-old child AMI Orientation Course

Who is this child who thirsts for knowledge and constantly asks “why”? What can the adult do to support this stage of development?

Jenny Höglund returns to Greece, via Zoom, for an AMI Orientation Seminar on children 6-12 years old. Her long experience in Montessori Elementary makes her one of the most experienced trainers in Europe. It was the children at her school who, by not wanting to leave, led her to advance her work and establish one of the first Montessori schools for adolescents. Jenny is an AMI 6-12 and 12-18 trainer. Furthermore, she holds the AMI Diploma for the Children's House (3-6 years).

This AMI 6-12 Orientation Seminar, held for the third time in Greece, is open to elementary and primary school teachers, parents and anyone seeking general knowledge about the Montessori approach to the Second Plane of Development. Jenny Höglund will describe in detail how an educational approach can respond to the needs and interests of a child of this age group, focusing on the importance of the imagination and “cosmic education”, the foundation of Montessori Elementary schools.

(The pedagogical materials used in the Montessori Elementary classroom, are not presented, as their presentation remains the exclusive responsibility of the fully trained Montessori 6-12 teacher.)

AMI Orientation Certificate (Association Montessori Internationale)

Note: Those who wish to train as Assistants for the 6-12 age group have the option to participate in the Assistants Adjunct Course, which will include 20 hours of additional training and will be conducted on site.
